Degree Requirements:

Submit official transcripts of all college level work from regionally accredited schools demonstrating: (a) a minimum of 2.2 GPA on a 4.0 scale, and RN-BSN and Elementary Ed 2.75 GPA and Social Work 2.5 GPA, and (b) the equivalent of 60 semester hours or an Associate degree. Students with 45 to 60 hours may apply for admission; however, they must meet with a King University academic counselor to develop a specific written plan to outline how they will complete the program within a reasonable amount of time after completing the required coursework at King University. Students with less than a 2.2 grade point average may be considered and accepted on a conditional basis, provided they are able to demonstrate a significant rationale for why they feel they will be successful in the King University program.
